The Firebaugh Police Department is currently searching for individuals interested in a part-time dispatch position. This individual will work 4 hours a day, or as needed. Other duties include clerical duties

This individual must be able to cover any shift, including holidays, weekends, and hold over into the next shift, if needed. Selected individuals will be exposed to privilege and confidential information, and will go through a thorough background process. - Undertake and satisfactorily complete required and assigned in-service training programs, as well as, other mandated training requirements.
- Think logically and act quickly in emergencies and judge situations and people accurately.
- Learn City geography, noting streets, building locations.
- Learn, understand, and interpret laws and regulations.
- Communicate in English clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.
- Successful completion of the department's field training program within 12 weeks.
- Must be flexible and work any shift (Day, Swing, and Graveyard), weekends, holidays, or as needed.
- Ability to learn and understand radio and statute code.

Immediately following the filing deadline, hopefuls who meet the minimum requirements will be scheduled for an oral interview, and Chief's interview.

Reference checks, Live Scan, Background Investigations, Physical testing are part of the employment process and background standards.

A final interview will be held with the Police Chief prior to appointment.
