## Water/Waste Water

The operation department has been working on the following:

1. Day to day operations of water/sewer plants.

- 2. Conducting preventative maintenance in the collections system.
- 3. Ripping and disking reclamation sites to prepare for upcoming Tomatek season.
- 4. Providing preventative maintenance on water/sewer plant equipment.
- 5. Conducting (Arkal System) filter trial at the waste water plant for removal of algae.
- 6. Spraying herbicides at waste water plant.

## **Streets**

The Street Department has been working on the following:

- 1. The PW crew has been performing street pothole repairs and street painting.
- 2. The new sweeper was delivered on June 3, 2014. Municipal Maintenance Equipment will be conducting training for the operation of the new street sweeper.

#### <u>Parks</u>

The Crew has been working on the following:

- 1. They continue to respond to calls regarding dog issues; four dogs were taken to Country Veterinary and two dogs were adopted.
- 2. They have been working on repairing irrigation leaks throughout the City landscape and parks areas.

## **City Projects:**

- 1. Maldonado lights project: Contractor is expecting the sport sentry system to be in next week and will pull the wire at that time.
- 2. Rolfe Construction will start the Bee Hive Drive and Helm Canal Road water line project and the sanitary sewer manhole replacement in June.
- 3. PG&E started the vegetation removal and restoration for the City of Firebaugh. PG&E will replant City trees, based on the selection from the city's approved list, at 1:1 ratio.
