Symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure

Slow the Spread



Wash Hands



Cover Cough



Avoid those who are sick

If hand washing is not available, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol

Social Distancing

- Avoid public gatherings, especially if sick people are present
- Maintain a minimum 6 feet of distance from others
- Avoid sharing objects
- Wash your hands and sanitize surfaces
- Individuals who are over 60 or have an underlying health condition are at higher risk
